SKILLS SESSIONS

No matter what standard you are – from beginner through to knowing what the dials are for – there is always something else to learn. Harvey Mills is running these very informative sessions which cover -

Camera Skills - aperture, shutter speed, ISO, equipment advice, focal lengths etc

Art of Photography - composition, texture, tone, colour, subject matter, etc

Controlling Light - session on managing natural, artificial and flash lighting under different conditions.

Absolute Beginner Sessions - those wishing to / considering entering prints into competition for the first time. Also relevant for those who have been taking photographs for a while, but need some theoretical / technical guidance.

Critiquing Workshop - facilitated group workshops where members discuss each others work and provide feedback to the photographer in a 'safe' environment. Will encourage people to 'think like a judge' and be more critical of their own work, etc.

The sessions are held in the **small hall at the URC Hall, Mengham, Hayling PO11 9EY**.

There is a small charge to cover the cost of hire of the hall. Experience has shown that these sessions are fun and valuable and further information on dates etc will be available shortly.
